He reported that the National budget has been drastically cut and a variety of programs will be affected. Region I ended the year with a surplus and offered to supplement the purchase of a vehicle for each State Association and offered to provide \$2000 emergency relief funding grants to 2 qualifying clubs within NYSW. NYSW will be applying for the TopSoccer and SoccerStart grants offered by the Region. Rich's feedback from the Recreational Workshop offered at the Region I meeting was positive.
